Biography

Bob Carter is a Research Professor at James Cook University (Queensland). He is a palaeontologist, stratigrapher and marine and environmental geologist with forty years professional experience, and holds degrees from the University of Otago (New Zealand) and the University of Cambridge (England). He has held tenured academic staff positions at the University of Otago and James Cook University (Townsville), where he was Professor and Head of School of Earth Sciences between 1981 and 1999.



Bob Carter's current research on climate change, sea-level change and stratigraphy is based on field studies of Cenozoic sediments (last 65 million years) from the Southwest Pacific region, especially the Great Barrier Reef and New Zealand.

Bob's research has been supported by grants from competitive public research agencies, especially the Australian Research Council (ARC). He receives no research funding from special interest organisations such as environmental groups, energy companies or government departments.

Bob writes public science commentary regularly in newspapers such as *The Australian*, *The Sydney Morning Herald*, *The Australian Financial Review* and the *UK Sunday Telegraph*.
